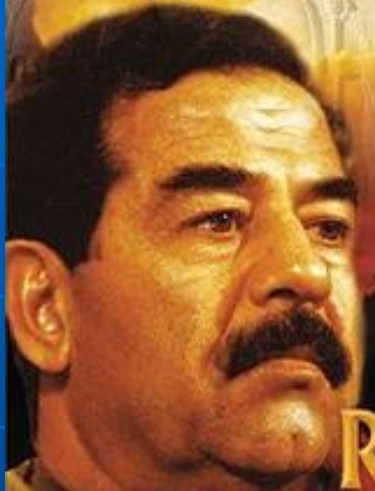

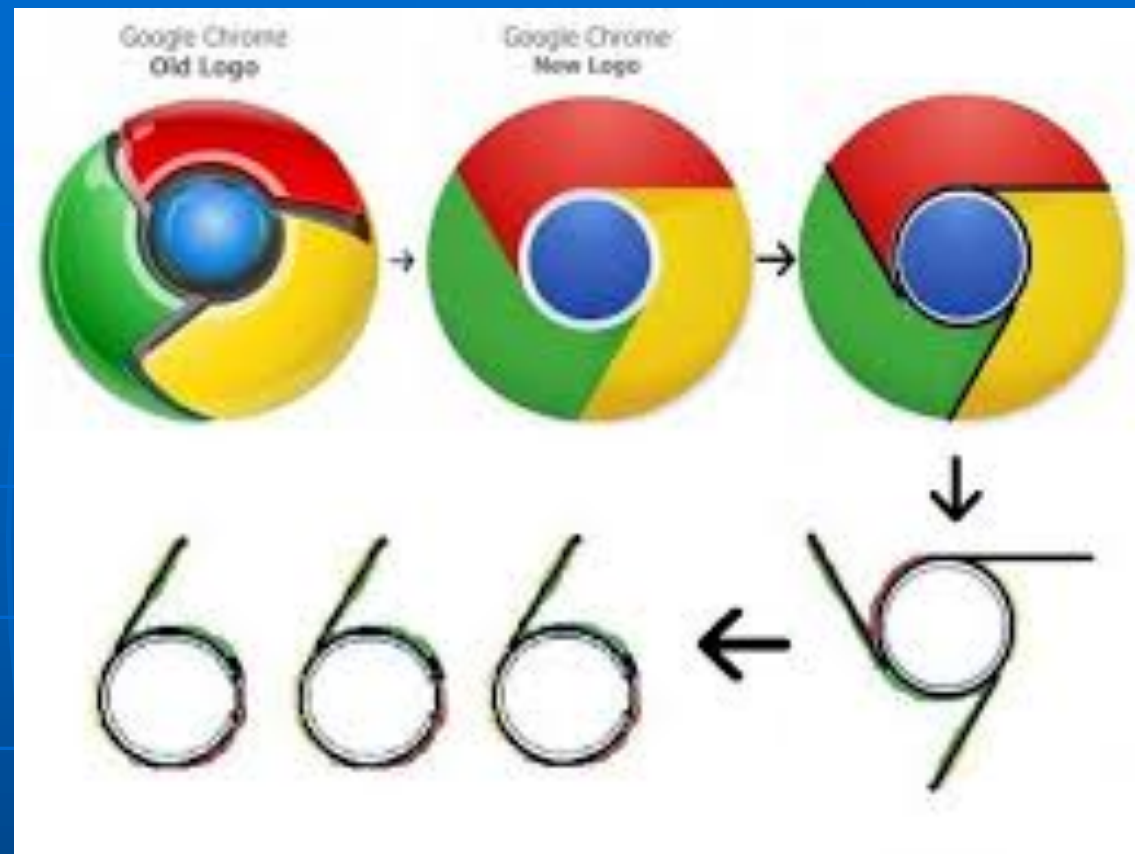

Mark of the Beast

**The Greek word for 'lamb' used
elsewhere is**

amnos

**meaning a lamb, and indicating its
sacrificial nature**

In Revelation it is

arnion

**speaking of the Lamb who has been
exalted on the basis of His triumphant
work at the cross**

***'Who is worthy to open the scroll and to
loose its seals?'***

(Rev.5:2)

'And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain...'

(Rev.5:6)

'Take these deeds, both this purchase deed which is sealed and this deed which is open, and put them in an earthen vessel, that they may last many days.' For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "Houses and fields and vineyards shall be possessed again in this land"'

***'Then He came and took the scroll
out of the right hand of Him who
sat on the throne'
(Rev.5:7)***

***'I was watching in the night visions,
and behold, one like the Son of
Man, coming with the clouds of
heaven! He came to the Ancient of
Days, and they brought Him near
before Him. Then to Him was given
dominion and glory and a kingdom
that all peoples, nations, and
languages should serve Him. His
dominion is an everlasting
dominion, which shall not pass
away, And His kingdom the one
which shall not be destroyed'***

(Dan.7:13-14)

'Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth'

(Rev.5:8-10)

'Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!"'

(Rev.5:11-12)

'And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!" Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever'

(Rev.5:13-14)

***'These are the ones who follow the
Lamb wherever He goes'***

(Rev.14:4)

***'Now I saw when the Lamb opened
one of the seals...'
(Rev.6:1)***

'They said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!"'

(Rev.6:16)

'After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"'

(Rev.7:9-10)

***'And I said to him, "Sir, you know."
So he said to me, "These are the ones
who come out of the great
tribulation, and washed their robes
and made them white in the blood of
the Lamb"'***
(Rev.7:14)

'...for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes'

(Rev.7:17)

***'These will make war with the Lamb,
and the Lamb will overcome them,
for He is Lord of lords and King of
kings; and those who are with Him
are called, chosen, and faithful'
(Rev.17:14)***

'Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready" ... Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'"
