Our Identity

We all have the same spirit, we are one in Christ
Our gifts differ, as God has freely given us
Our work differs, the work predestined by our Father



- Shame can form a large portion of a person soulish identity
- Our New Creation Spirit does not experience, guilt, shame, nor any other human condition
 - > Who we are in Christ now, is who we will be in eternity
 - > We don't dwell on our inheritance or rewards

What is Shame?

Shame is defined as a painful feeling of humiliation or distress caused by the consciousness of wrong or foolish behaviour

Shame can be established via the foolish behaviour of another

Deep shame is something that has really rocked you, really shaken you to the core

> Fleeting shame, comes via minor indiscretions

Flesh or Spirit

We can walk of the flesh or walk in the spirit

We can get a seared conscience by continually walking of the flesh

We all still sin, believe the wrong things at times, believe snippets of lies or untruths, no one is perfect

> We have all fallen short and our flesh will never measure up

A seared conscience is diminished by the renewing of the mind, and walking in the spirit becomes an easier choice

Adam and Eve

The very first instance of shame in creation was felt by Adam and Eve

This incident is the very reason we inhabit a fleshly body

This incident caused Adam and Eve to have an instant consciousness of guilt and shame

Created in His Image

"So God created man in His own image; in the image of God, He created him; male and female He created them." Genesis 1:27

"Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." Genesis 1:28

The Garden

"See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which there is life, I have given every green herb for food"; and it was so. Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good....."

The Fall

> Adam and Eve were the first saints

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

Shame has no Favourites Bad News

Shame can become a major part of a person identity

Shame is a universal condition, it can affect anyone

> There are many varying roads to shame

Good News

> God's Forgiveness

New Identity in Christ

> We can't have more of Him, but our flesh can emulate Him more! We are 100% Sufficient in Christ Jesus

What about us? How do we contend with shame, how do we get victory over shame?

Shame has a universal cure, and that cure is Christ Jesus

The finished work of Jesus gave us a new creation spirit, and that spirit is 100% holy and righteous, it does not experience any guilt, nor any shame, and it's our greatest defence and extinguisher of shame

So how do we put the past in the past, how do we disenfranchise our today self, from the self of the past, or even recent events?

The Really Good News

"Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:1-2

Faith

This statement is really just encouraging us, to just let it all go, to put aside every weight, and every sin that easily ensnares, so we can run with endurance, the race that is set before us

We can let it all go, because Jesus did the work, His finished work

It's by faith we are saved, it's by faith we keep our eyes forward on Christ, and His life in us, that's leading us. And it's also by faith that we let go of the past, deal with the past, and let the past be what it is....the past. We are putting aside every weight, so God can move us forward in life, the life He has destined us to live.

No Condemnation

"There is therefore now No Condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus" Romans 8:1

> By no means, can be condemned for any sin, done, doing or going to do, because we are "In Christ", and He took our penalty for sin

Do Not Grieve the Holy Spirit

"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." Ephesians 4:30

> We can grieve the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is a person, and He intercedes for us continually, He prays for us, He is super involved in our lives

Ultimately the biggest dismantler of shameful feelings is forgiveness

Convicted of Righteousness

"And when He has come (The Holy Spirit), He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment." John 16:8

> We are continually being convicted of His righteousness

> He is saying, you are wonderful, you are holy, you are righteous, you are beautiful to me, you are my son, my daughter, I will never leave you, nor forsake you, I call you friend, I'm the lover of your soul, I have plans for you, I have given you a hope and a future, I am your councillor and I know your inner most thoughts, and when I look at you, I see the apple of my eye.

Shame Vs God's Glory

Shame will tell you

You're worthless You're hopeless You're broken You're never good enough You'll never make it You'll never measure up To stop trying To stop assuming you'll have a good life To just give up To lay down in defeat To walk around with your head down To assume to worst

God's Glory will tell you You're Holy You're Righteous You're Loved You're Forgiven You're Made Perfect You're a New Creation You're Delighted in You Have all Sufficiency You're Complete You're More than a Conqueror You're a son You're a daughter

You're the Beloved

Clothed in His Glory

> We are clothed in His Glory, we aren't clothed in shame

> We just keep our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith

We meditate on the wonderful glory that we are born out of, and that we are made of, our New Creation person, the Heavenly person that we are

> We are seated at the right hand of the Father, in Glory

Despising the Shame

"Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

Hebrews 12:1-2

Despising the Shame

Shame was stripping away every earthly support that Jesus had

Jesus put away with this shame, He despised it, because of the joy that was set before Him

Jesus was on the cross looking forward, just as He did through His entire ministry

What do we do with Shame?

> We despise it, we disown it, we throw it to the gutter, we give it no life, we give it no breath, we give it no purpose

> What's done is done, and we move on, we don't linger there, we as Jesus did look eternally forward, we keep our eyes on Him, just as He kept His eyes on the Father

The dignity of Jesus was stripped away on the cross, but with it, He took our indignity, and when He was raised up, He also raised us up in His heavenly dignity, His glory and His righteousness. He passed through death to life, and He brought us with Him

His Glorious Riches

"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19

> When we understand the grace, we have been given, the fullness of His love, and His wonderful counsel and comfort, well, when we have our eyes fixed on Christ, that is what we are seeing. We are gazing upon who we are in Him, we are gazing upon the Living Word that He is, we are gazing upon every promise, every truth of contentment, and every essence that gives us peace, tranquillity, and rest

Everyone walks different

Everyone's walk with the Lord is different. Some run, some saunter along, some duck and weave, some take two steps forward and one step back....some find it mostly an uphill battle, and some jolly along with not much hinderance
