Ready And Prepared For Stressful Times

'Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world... Only Luke is with me... Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm... At my first defense no one stood with me, but all forsook me. May it not be charged against them'

(2 Tim.4:10,11,14&16)

'Bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas when you come and the books, especially the parchments'

(2 Tim.4:13)

'But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come...' (2 Tim.3:1)

'For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without selfcontrol, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!'

(2 Tim.3:2-5)

The characteristics Paul describes speak not of bad times but of bad people

The first of the qualities mentioned is a life that is centred in self

The adjective used is philautos, which means self-loving, i.e. the centre of gravity of the natural man is self rather than God

'...evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived'

(2 Tim.3:13)

Evil men = open enemies of Jesus

Impostors = tares amongst the wheat

How to be prepared for these difficult times

All opposition can be answered by the Word of God

'Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel, for which I suffer trouble as an evildoer, even to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained'

(2 Tim.2:8-9)

Why was he so confident in it?

Because it is the Word of God

'All Scripture is given by inspiration of God...'

(2 Tim.3:16)

'But, anyone can write a book and claim it's God's Word'

The Bible gives a satisfactory explanation to the whole of life's situation

- the true origins and source of all things
- how suffering came into the world
- the purpose of life
- life after death
- the way of salvation
- how we can know God and have a relationship with Him

The Bible is a book which has dramatically changed the lives of hundreds of millions of people

'For the word of God is <u>living and</u> <u>powerful</u>, and <u>sharper than any two-edged sword</u>, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is <u>a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart</u>'

(Heb.4:12)

The Bible has been attacked more than any other book in history

It has been banned, burned, mocked, twisted, assailed by every kind of enemy, including Roman emperors, skeptics, philosophers, athiests, clergy living in the Middle Ages (and modern times), archaeologists, communist dictators, scientists, etc.

Yet, survived for thousands of years and proven to be indestructible

The Bible is 30% prophetic

*Foretelling the history of nations

*The advent of the Saviour

*The future of Israel

"Present your case," says the LORD. "Bring forth your strong reasons," says the King of Jacob. "Let them bring forth and show us what will happen; let them show the former things, what they were, that we may consider them, and know the latter end of them; or declare to us things to come. Show the things that are to come hereafter, that we may know that you are gods; yes, do good or do evil, that we may be dismayed and see it together. Indeed you are nothing, and your work is nothing; he who chooses you is an abomination""

(Isa.41:21-24)

The Bible was written by 40 contributors over 1600 years

These writers came from different walks of life with vast differences in background, education, vocabulary and occupations

They wrote in many different locations and from various countries and on three continents

Yes, evil men and imposters will get worse and worse

But the Word of God is greater than all

"All flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away, But the word of the Lord endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you' (1 Pet.1:24-25)

'...from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work' (2 Tim.3:15-17)

- 1) Believe the Word of God because through it we are saved
- 2) Read and hear it because it will keep us straight in a crooked world.

Doctrine – reproof – correction - instruction

'So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified' (Acts 20:32)

- 3) Trust it because it will completely equip us for every good work
- 4) Be mentored by those build on it

 'But you have carefully followed my
 doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith,
 longsuffering, love,
 perseverance, persecutions, afflictions...'
 (2 Tim.3:10-11)

5) Share it with the world

'Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching' (2 Tim.4:2)
