'And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth'

(Jn.1:14)

'Great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh' (1 Tim.3:16)

'For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily' (Col.2:9)

'Now a mediator does not mediate for one only, but God is one' (Gal.3:20)

'Nor is there any mediator between us, who may lay his hand on us both'

(Job 9:33)

'Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross' (Phil.2:5-8)

'Then Jesus answered and said to them,
"Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can
do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the
Father do; for whatever He does, the Son
also does in like manner"

'I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me' (Jn.5:30)

'For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me' (Jn.6:38)

'Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness' (Lk.4:1)

'But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you'

(Matt.12:28)

'He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked' (1 Jn.2:6)

'Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have' (Luke 24:39)

'For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself'

'For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus'

(1 Tim.2:5)

'For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren...
