...Now one of Saul's servants was there that day, detained before the LORD; he was Doeg the Edomite, Saul's chief shepherd.




"'Saul has slain his thousands, and David his tens of thousands'?"

David left Gath and escaped to the cave of Adullam.







About four hundred men were with him.




#### ▶ PS 142:



 Distressed, In Debt, Discontented men become mighty warriors under David's leadership

- 1. Josheb-Basshebeth, a Tahkemonite, chief of the Three. "He raised his spear against eight hundred men whom he killed in one encounter" (2 Samuel 23:8).
- 2. Eleazar son of Dodai the Ahohite. "The men of Israel retreated, but he stood his ground and struck down the Philistines till his hand grew tired and froze to the sword" (2 Samuel 23:9-10).
- 3. Shammah son of Agee the Hararite. "Israel's troops fled from [the Philistines], but Shammah took his stand in the middle of the field. He defended it and struck the Philistines down" (2 Samuel 23:11-12).

Abishai the brother of Joab son of Zeruiah was chief of the Three. "He raised his spear against three hundred men, whom he killed" (2 Samuel 23:18).



➤ Benaiah son of Jehoiada from Kabzeel, in charge of his bodyguard. "He struck down two of Moab's best men. He also went down into a pit on a snowy day and killed a lion. And he struck down a huge Egyptian ... and killed him with his own spear." (2 Samuel 23:20-21)
