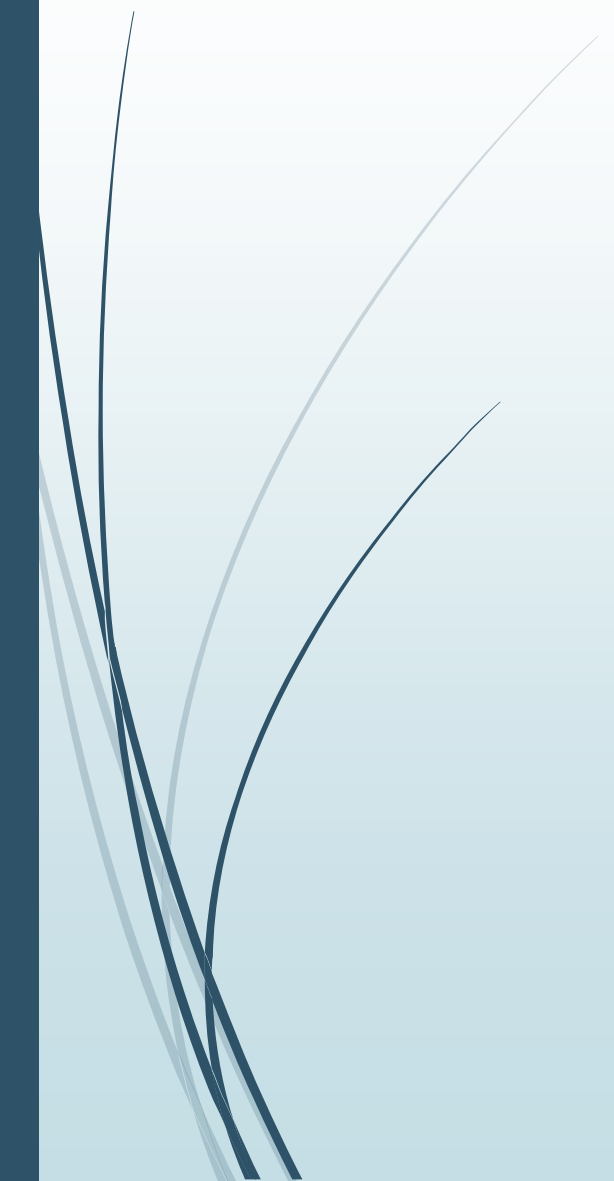
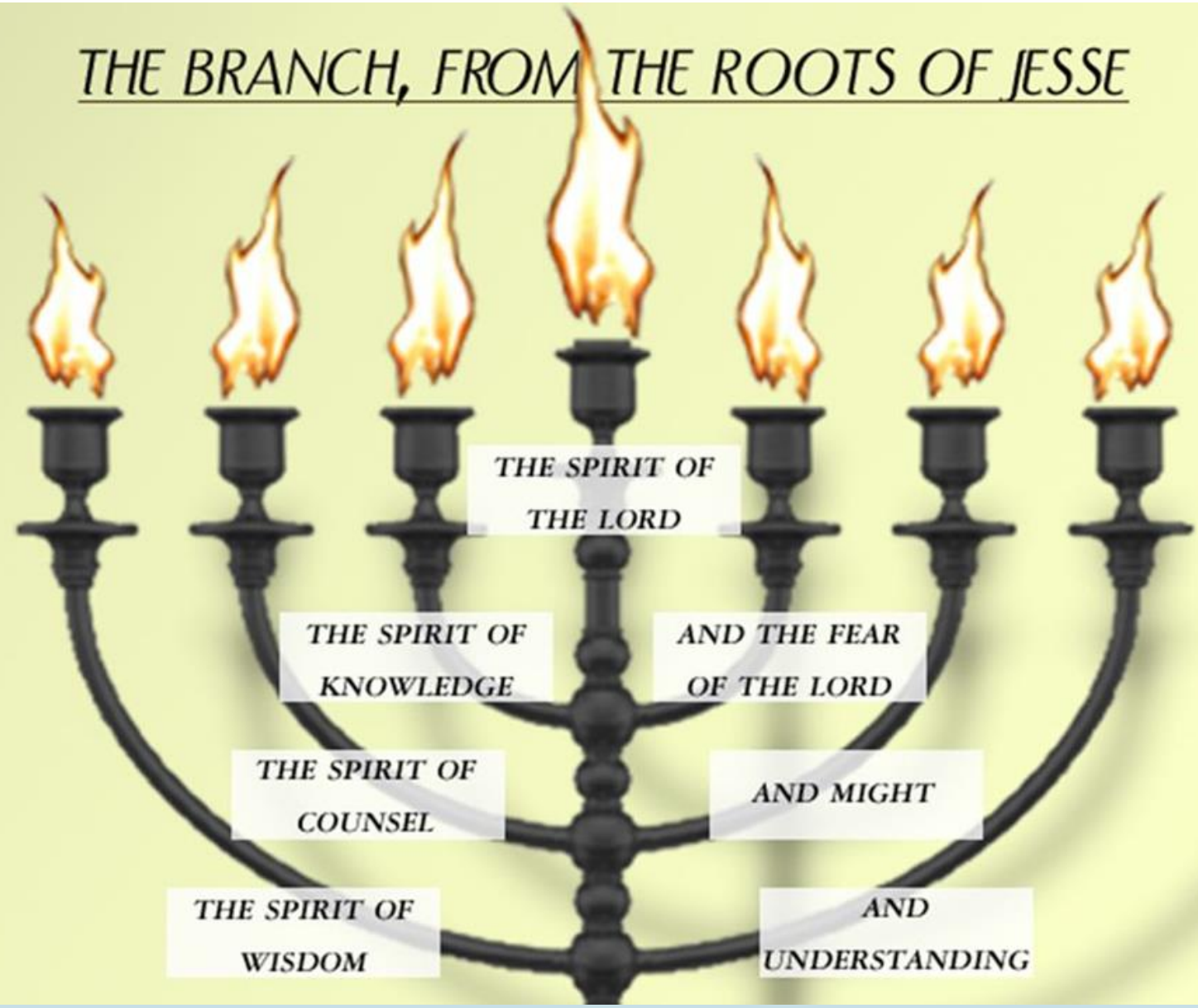

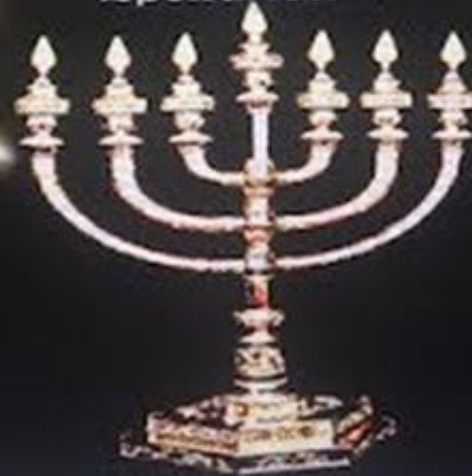


Zechariah 4:2-7
