*For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous." Romans 5:19 (NASB)*  *What shall we say then? Romans 7:7 (NASB)*  'for until the Law sin was in the world, but sin is not counted against anyone when there is no law. 14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the violation committed by Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come." Romans 5:13-14(NASB) ' But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit with Him. type of Him who was to come." Corinthians 6:17(NASB)

## *`for the one who has died is freed from sin. Romans 6:7 (NASB)*

*`For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under the Law but under grace.. Romans 6:14(NASB)* 

*`But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching to which you were entrusted, Romans 6:17(NASB)* 

'I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly." Galatians 2:21(NASB) 'Is the Law then contrary to the promises of God? [a]Far from it! For if a law had been given that was able to impart life, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law. But the Scripture has confined everyone under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. Galatians 3:21-22(NASB) ' For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. Hebrews 10:14(NASB) 'He made Him who knew no sin to be sin in our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. Corinthians 5:21(NASB) *'knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; Romans 6:6 (NASB)* 

*Romans* 6:1-7 New American Standard Bible Believers Are Dead to Sin, Alive to God 6 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? 2 [a]Far from it! How shall we who died to sin still live in it? 3 Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have become [b]united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be [c]in the likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old [d]self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be [e]done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; 7 for the one who has died is [f]freed from sin.

'But far be it from me to boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Galatians 6:14 (NASB) *'When He said, "A new covenant," He has made the first obsolete. But whatever is becoming obsolete and growing old is about to disappear. Hebrews 9:28 (NASB) 'For all who are of works of [a]the Law are under a curse; for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not abide by all the things written in the book of the Law, to do them." Galatians 3:10 (NASB) *`For whoever keeps the whole Law, yet stumbles in one point, has become guilty of all. James 2:10 (NASB)* 

'Therefore sin is not to reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts, Romans 6:12 (NASB) 'But sin, taking an opportunity through the commandment, produced in me coveting of every kind; for apart from the Law sin is dead. Romans 7:8 (NASB)
