**30 Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them.**

**31 Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight.**






**Luke 24:32 (NKJV)**

**32 And they said to one another, "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?"**





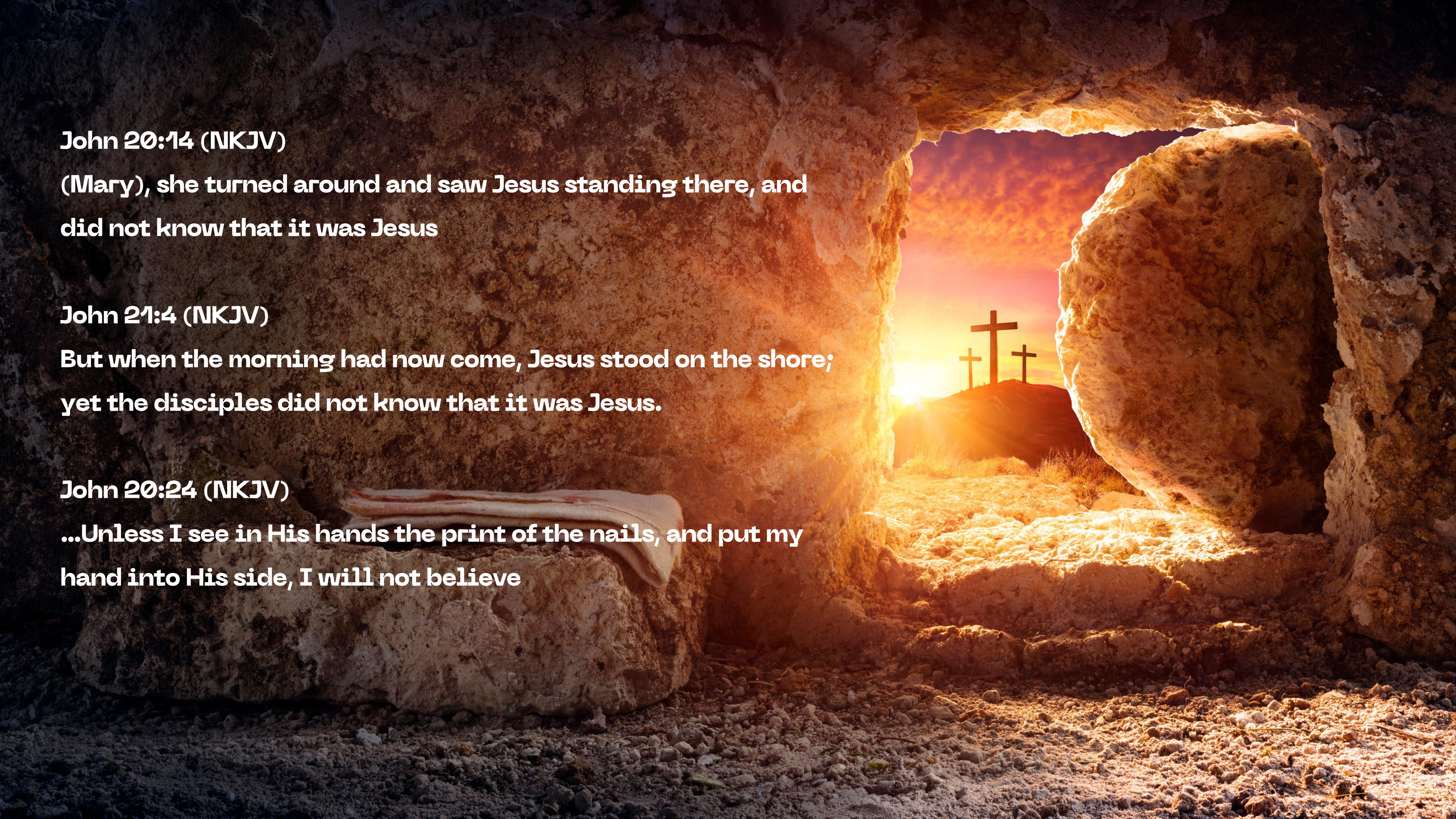

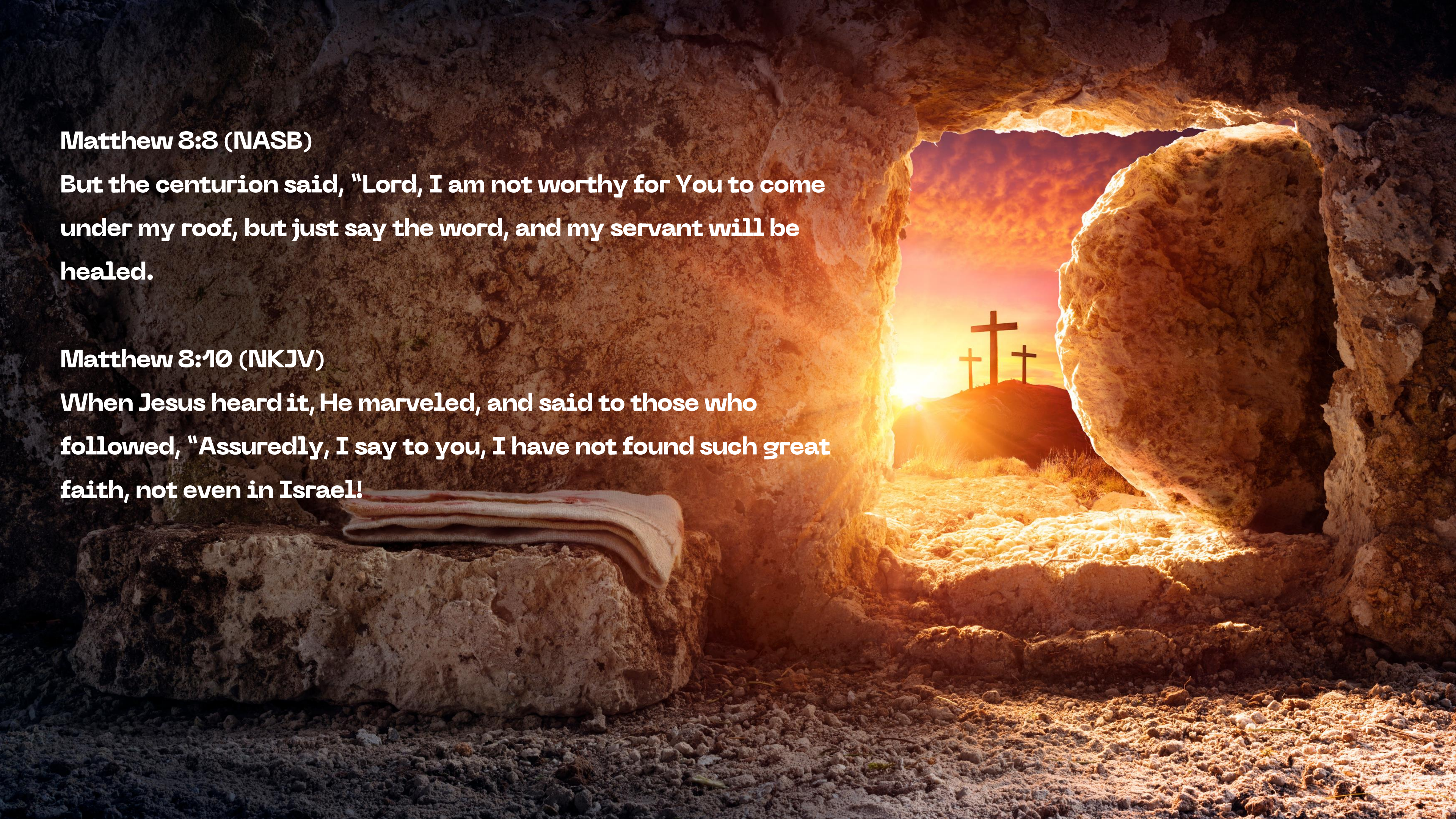


**Matthew 8:8 (NASB)**
