



And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

Mark of the Beast

**The symbol most used in Revelation is
that of a lamb (28 times)**

**The Greek word for 'lamb' used
elsewhere is**

amnos

**meaning a lamb, and indicating its
sacrificial nature**

In Revelation it is

arnion

**speaking of the Lamb who has been
exalted on the basis of His triumphant
work at the cross**

**Rev.5 sets the scene for the book and
helps us to understand why the title
'Lamb' is favoured**

***'Who is worthy to open the scroll and to
loose its seals?'***

(Rev.5:2)

- ✓ **The scroll is the title deed of the earth**
- ✓ **The earth is the Lord's (Psa.24:1), and rulership of it was entrusted to man. This has always been God's purpose for the earth, and still is**
- ✓ **But through the Fall it was usurped by Satan. He took it by stealth and is now known as the god and ruler of this world**
- ✓ **Satan offered the kingdoms of the world to Jesus by receiving worship from Him**
- ✓ **Of course, Jesus rejected this offer choosing to repossess the earth legitimately, fulfilling the requirements of a kinsman-redeemer**

- ✓ **No heavenly being was found worthy to take the scroll and open the seals because God intended earth to be ruled by humans**
- ✓ **No one on the earth was worthy. Any potential redeemer of sinful humanity had to be without sin**
- ✓ **The scroll was bound with seemingly unbreakable seals. John wept, literally, 'I burst into tears and continued weeping'**
- ✓ **One of the 24 elders told John to weep no more because the Lion of the tribe of Judah had prevailed. But when John looked he did not see a Lion, but a Lamb**

'And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain...'

(Rev.5:6)

**The Lamb paid the redemption price
2,000 years ago**

**Now it was time to take possession of
what was legally His**

This is illustrated in Jeremiah 32:6-15

'Take these deeds, both this purchase deed which is sealed and this deed which is open, and put them in an earthen vessel, that they may last many days. For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "Houses and fields and vineyards shall be possessed again in this land"'

(Jer.32:14-15)

**John, in the Spirit, saw that
moment at the end of the age when
Jesus would assert His right as Lord
and owner of the earth**

***'Then He came and took the scroll
out of the right hand of Him who
sat on the throne'***

(Rev.5:7)

'I was watching in the night visions, and behold, one like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed'

(Dan.7:13-14)

**Chapter 5 closes with the 4 living
creatures and 24 elders worshipping
the Lamb**

Then many angels with the elders

**Finally every creature in heaven and
on earth and under the earth and in
the sea**

*'Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the **Lamb**, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth"'*

(Rev.5:8-10)

*'Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the **Lamb** who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!"'*

(Rev.5:11-12)

*'And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, And to the **Lamb**, forever and ever!" Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever'*

(Rev.5:13-14)

From this point on, throughout the remainder of the book until its final chapter, the Lamb is center stage

'These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes'
(Rev.14:4)

**It is the Lamb who has control of the
end time proceedings**

**When He loosens the seals, events
unfold**

***'Now I saw when the **Lamb** opened
one of the seals...'
(Rev.6:1)***

After the 6th seal, the inhabitants of the world become aware that the Day of Judgment is approaching and that all judgment has been given to the Lamb

'They said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!"'
(Rev.6:16)

Meanwhile, in heaven, the redeemed who have been raptured stand before the throne of God giving glory to Him and to the Lamb for their redemption

*'After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the **Lamb**, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the **Lamb!**"'*

(Rev.7:9-10)

**We don't live in dread of the tribulation
because we will overcome by the blood
of the Lamb**

*'And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So
he said to me, "These are the ones who
come out of the great tribulation, and
washed their robes and made them
white in the blood of the **Lamb**"'*
(Rev.7:14)

The saints of all ages, now glorified and with Christ in heaven, will continue to be ministered to by the Lamb

'...for the **Lamb** who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes'

(Rev.7:17)

The Marriage of the Lamb will take place in heaven

*'Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the **Lamb** has come, and His wife has made herself ready" ... Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the **Lamb!**'"'*

(Rev.19:7&9)

**(Note: Now we are the body of Christ;
then the bride of Christ)**

Just as the Lamb opened the end times proceedings by loosening the first seal, so He will bring this age to a conclusion at the battle of Armageddon

The Beast will lead a global army, including the ten kings, against Him but will be defeated

'These will make war with the **Lamb**, and the **Lamb** will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful'
(Rev.17:14)

As the scene in heaven passes to eternity the Lamb is still the preferred title for Jesus. The Bride is referred to as the Lamb's wife

'Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the **Lamb's wife**"'
(Rev.21:9)

**The foundations of the New Jerusalem bear
the names of the apostles of the Lamb**

***'Now the wall of the city had twelve
foundations, and on them were the
names of the twelve apostles of the
Lamb'***

(Rev.21:14)

It is all about the Lamb

**We are saved by the Lamb, and will reign
with the Lamb - not by cracking the end
times code**

***'Then He who sat on the throne said,
"Behold, I make all things new." And He
said to me, "Write, for these words are
true and faithful." And He said to me, "It
is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega,
the Beginning and the End. I will give of
the fountain of the water of life freely to
him who thirsts'***

(Rev.21:5-6)

- ✓ **'It is finished!' vs 'It is done!' There is a difference**
- ✓ **'It is finished' means that the work of redemption is completed, nothing remains outstanding**
- ✓ **But 'It is done' means that which was completed is now fully manifested. Future hope becomes present glory**
- ✓ **No more will we walk by faith but by sight. No longer will we see through a glass dimly but face to face**
